- ✓ Be a resident of Chester or Andover;
- ✓ Be willing and able to follow directions and care for the garden during the growing season;
- ✓ Have a mostly flat, clear area free of trees, bushes, pathways, etc., that is a minimum of 12'x15';
- ✓ Have your garden area get at least 8 hours of sun during the summer leafed-out months;
- ✓ Have some rocks to hold down the landscape fabric;
- ✓ Have a water source (or watering jug) for your garden;
- ✓ Attend all four gardening classes.

- 9'x12' heavy-duty landscape fabric;
- trowel, weeding tool, work gloves;
- bag each of compost, potting soil, sand;
- container for mixing soil and collecting produce;
- seeds and plants, fertilizer, old milk jug;
- planting map and written instructions;
- four classes (on preparation, growing, harvesting, and cooking) to be held at St. Luke's Willard Hall, 313 Main St., Chester, 802-875-6000, on Thursdays 10-12 AM: May 14, June 18, July 16, & August 20.
