SCREENING CRITERIA

- The plan must be so attractive to families that they want to move to the district.
- Maintains the integrity of current elementary schools.
- Achieves equity for all students through increased quality—not through reducing quality in some schools (i.e.—an atmosphere of excellence).
- Assures that transport times are not excessive.
- Promotes strong relationships among students, adults, and community members.

DECISION CRITERIA (Spread 100 points of value across the criteria)

_____ Increases student opportunity, equity, and quality for students.

There must be measurable benefits for students at the elementary, middle school, and high school levels.

_____ Decreases/moderates overall cost per student. Provides for efficiencies.

_____ Increases transparency and accountability.

_____ Assures that transportation times are acceptable and reasonable.

_____ Provides homestead taxpayers the opportunity to gain incentives and protections.

_____ Prevents State Board action to realign districts.
