River Birch (Betula nigra 'Heritge'). Zones 4-9. Grows 40-70' h x 40-60' w. Native, fast-growing, light shade tree clump. Exfoliating, creamy/tan bark reveals inner layer of paler, salmon pink. Dark green leaves turn yellow in fall. Full sun to part sun. Focal point alone or by terrace. Adaptable to soil types, drought, wet. Resists common diseases. Resistant to strong winds and ice.



'Miss Kim' Lilac (Syringa pubescens patula). Zones 4-8. Grows 4-6' h/w. More compact, dense, deciduous, nonsuckering Korean shrub. Smaller, lavender, fragrant blooms on old wood May-June. Dark green leaves turn burgundy red in fall. Full to part sun. Tolerates range of well-drained alkaline soil. Resists mildew. Prune shape after bloom. Attracts bees, butterflies.



Rosebay Rhododendron (*Rhododendron maximum roseum*) Zones 3-7. Grows 5-15' h/w. Native, spreading, suckering, evergreen shrub. Big, showy, rosy-pink blooms June-July. Deadheading encourages blooms. Prune after blooming. Large leathery, evergreen leaves. Avoid hot locations and strong winds. Prefers part shade to full sun, but tolerates full sun, heavy shade, drought, rabbits. Prefers moist, well-drained, humusy soil. Do not cultivate around shallow, fibrous root system. Mulch with wood chips, bark, pine needles. Atracts bees, butterflies. All parts toxic.





Oakleaf Hydrangea (Hdrangea quercifolia). Zones 5/4-9. Grows 4-8' h/w. Native, upright, deciduous shrub, roots at elbows. White, pyramidal, showy blooms on old wood in mid summer good for cut or dried flowers. Handsome, dark green leaves turn red, purple, bronze in fall. Cinnamon-brown peeling bark after leaves fall for winter interest. Well-drained soil, light tolerant. Full sun, part afternoon shade to full. Mulch w/bark. Plant in sheltered location or wrap w/burlap in winter if in very windy or sunny location. Attracts bees, butterflies. Seeds attract songbirds.



Sweetshrub or Carolina Allspice (Calycanthus floridus)). Zones 4-9. Grows 6' h/4-5' w. Native, rounded, deciduous, suckering shrub. Large, showy, fragrant, burgundy blooms on new and old wood April-July. Prune after blooming for shape or to control suckers. Lustrous green leaves with pale undersides turn yellow in fall. Sun to part shade. Trouble free. Soil tolerant. Attracts bees, butterflies.
